WINTON SCHOOL OUT OF ZONE ENROLMENTS 2020

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Winton School has determined that 5 places in Year 0 (New Entrants) are likely to be available for out-of-zone students from the beginning of next year.

Please contact the school office on 03 236 7238 or email admin@winton.school.nz to apply. The deadline for receipt of applications for out of zone places is **Friday 6 December, 2019**.

If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required, it will be held on **Monday 9 December, 2019**. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

A precise description of the home zone may be viewed at the School Office or Ministry of Education website. If you live in the home zone and have not yet signalled your intention to enrol your child, please contact Winton School as soon as possible, to assist us to plan appropriately.
