

UNIFORM GUIDELINES

RATIONALE

A compulsory school uniform provides a sense of belonging, and promotes pride in one-self and pride in ones school.

GUIDELINES

- The school uniform will be compulsory for all students from the beginning of Term One 2008. That
 is to say, that all enrolments at Winton School will be conditional on having a school uniform within
 one week of their first day of school.
- 2. Details of where parents/caregivers can purchase Winton School uniform will be given out in the School Information pack.
- 3. Families who experience difficulties in purchasing a School uniform can discuss this with the School Principal. Work and Income New Zealand may provide some families with assistance of uniform cost.
- 4. The uniform policy does not allow the wearing of jewellery or makeup, except of a watch and or plain studs or keeper earrings. Long hair is to be tied back and away from the face.
- 5. As of Term 1 2012 an addition to the school uniform will include red sports top and black shorts as compulsory sports uniform. PE uniform is compulsory and we do ask parents/caregivers to ensure pupils are prepared for sport with appropriate clothing on a daily basis.
- 6. The Winton School PTA offer a second hand uniform shop, details of whom to contact are available at the school office.
- 7. When representing Winton School at various sporting events the school sports uniform shall be worn.
- 8. Failure to wear uniform correctly will be dealt with through the Principal or Pastoral Care Team.

CURRENT UNIFORM DETAIL

Wearing the correct school uniform is a source of pride for our school. Your support in ensuring your child comes to school each day dressed in the correct uniform is appreciated.

Girls Uniform:

- Shirt: White long sleeved blouse or short-sleeved shirt.
- Top: Midnight navy v-neck jersey/cardigan or dark navy polar fleece.

- Skirt: Tartan pinafore, culottes or pleated skirt.
- Socks: White ankle socks all year round. Navy tights may be worn in winter during Terms 2 & 3 and up to Labour Weekend in Term 4.
- Shoes: Black leather school shoes (please see over).
 Unisex black or brown dress sandals during Term 1 and 4 only.

Boys Uniform:

- Shirt: Navy long or short sleeved shirt
- Top: Midnight navy v-neck jersey or dark navy polar fleece.
- Shorts: Grey shorts or grey long dress pants
- Socks: Grey with red/navy stripe
- Shoes: Black dress shoes (please see over)
 Unisex black or brown dress sandals during Term 1 and 4 only.

Boys and Girls:

- Sports/PE Uniform: Plain black shorts and Winton sports top for PE/Sport. Black track pants may be worn in Winter. Sports shoes for PE/Sport.
- Hats: Red wide brimmed or bucket style sunhats (available from the office)
- Long hair needs to be all tied up, if it is longer than the collar or falls in the child's face. Plain red/black/brown/white or blue hair ties/clips/bands.
- No hair colouring.
- No jewellery, nail polish or makeup except watch and/or plain studs or keeper earrings.
- White or navy blue polyprop tops / t-shirts can be worn under shirts.
- A plain navy or black jacket can be worn over the polar fleece when very cold.
- Scarves, hats and jackets are not to be worn in class.
- School uniform is to be worn to and from school.
- A high viz vest is to be worn to and from school all year round. These are issued from the
 office.
